City of Warren burn regulations

- 1. All burning whether in a container or in the open requires a permit in advance of burning.
- 2. Permits are free, and may be obtained by calling 870-226-8302.
- 3. You must attend your fire at all times.
- 4. No petroleum based products shall be burned. (tires, roofing, plastic)
- 5. You must have a water hose connected or other means of controlling the fire available at all times.
- 6. Fire must be out by sunset.
- 7. All fires must be a minimum of 15 feet from any structures.
- 8. It is unlawful to deposit any combustible material such as limbs, leaves, and grass clippings into any ditch, street, alley, or on public property of the City.
- 9. It is unlawful to burn anything in or on any ditch, street, alley, or on public property.
- 10. You must call prior to igniting any fire to check on weather conditions and possible burn bans.
- 11. Violators of this ordinance if found guilty may be fined up to \$500 dollars.

Whenever a burn ban is issued no burning of any kind is allowed.
