# General Information

The Warren Branch Library is one of nine branch libraries in the Southeast Arkansas Regional Library system. Our purpose is to provide our community with access to all of the materials and services within our system. The library will provide the best services it can within the limits of its budget.


The following general guidelines help us achieve this goal:

- The first library card is free to any person living within the 5county system once application requirements are met.
- Replacement cards are \$2.
- Parents are responsible for all items their children check out.
- Copier assistance available; the library is <u>not</u> responsible for copies made by patrons.
- Access to public computers requires a library card and is regulated by the Computer Usage Policy.

### **COMPUTER USAGE POLICY**

- Public computer users must have their library card number to sign-in (no overdues or fines).
- 2 hours per day guaranteed-additional time allotted if demand is low.
- Black & white prints can be made from the computers; patrons must pay \$0.20 for each page printed.
- Follow SEARLibrary Internet Use Policy (posted near computers).

Certain restrictions may apply depending on demand and other circumstances.



Warren Library currently has 10 computers available for public use. Patrons also have access to free Wi-Fi available 24/7 and reaches the parking lots.

### LIBRARY BEHAVIOR POLICY

Certain restrictions may apply, depending on collection strength, demand, and material type.

Library of Things Items:

Book renewals may be done by phone. Fine for all book materials is \$0.10/day. Maximum book fine limit is \$6.00.

DVD/Binge Box overdue fine is \$1.00/day.

Patrons are financially responsible for damaged/lost items.
